Cupertino City-wide Earthquake Drill

- Goal – Contact all city residents in the event of a city-wide disaster/emergency
- Purpose – refine the City’s ability to deploy Cupertino Citizen Corp (CCC) to support an extended field deployment –
Question: Can We Really do this????
Answer: We are going to find out!

MRC – Block Leaders

ARKs – Organized Neighborhoods

Exercise Schedule


Saturday, October 17, 2009

10:00	Drill Begins, Earthquake event occurs
10:00	Begin 1 st Operational Period, 10:00am to 2:00pm
13:00	Begin 2 nd Operational Period, 1:00pm to 5:00pm
16:00	Begin 3 rd Operational Period, 4:00pm to 8:00pm
20:00	End of 3 rd Operational Period, secure deployment for Day 1

Sunday, October 18, 2009

12:00	Begin 4 th Operational Period, 12:00pm to 3:30pm
15:30	Begin 5 th Operational Period, 3:30pm to 6:30pm
18:30	End of 5 th Operational Period, secure deployment for Day 2


