

July 4 Fireworks Event

- 30 minute show, starting 1 hour after sunset
- Tradition for many years
 - Suspended in 2015 and 2016 due to venue issues and drought
- Viewing sites were city parks and schools
 - Recreation dept. hosts activities for children
 - Public arrives up to 3 hours early
- Citizen Corps Roles
 - CARES
 - Communication link between venues and command post
 - Rovers along perimeter of launch site
 - MRC
 - Staff first aid stations at venues
 - CERT
 - Rovers at venues
 - Incident commanders at venues

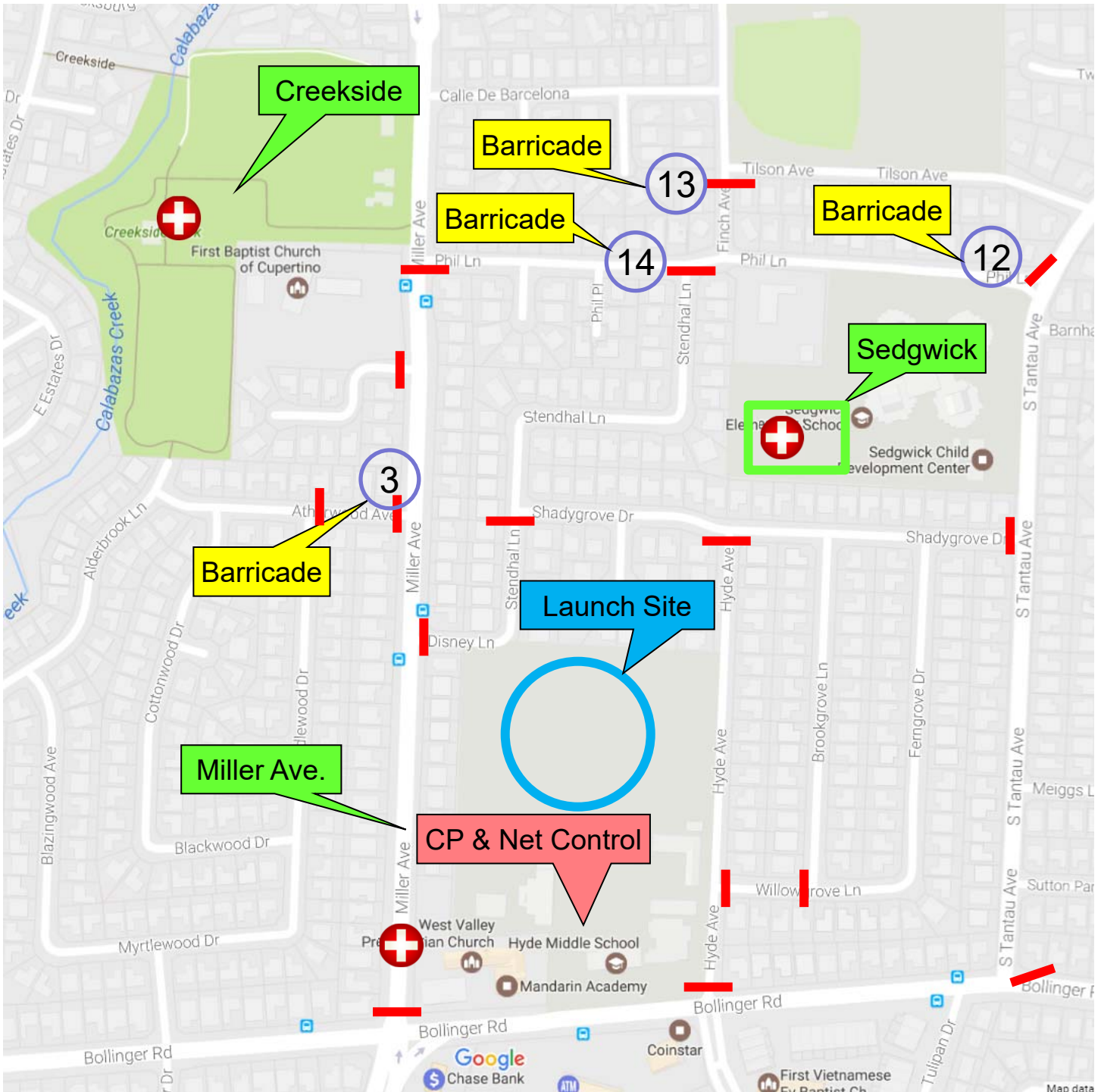
July 4 Event: Scope

- Smaller in scope

Attribute	Historic	2017
Shell size	4" / 400'	3" / 300'
Launch site	Cupertino HS	Hyde MS
Viewing venues	Creekside Park Hyde MS Sedgwick ES	Sedgwick ES Creekside (partial) Miller Ave.
CCC staff	60+	≥ 40

- CCC scope requirements
 - MRC: 3 stations, 1 at each venue
 - CARES & CERT:
 - Staff at least 4 barricades
 - Hyde drop off zone: 3 – 4 monitor drop off
 - Presbyterian Church fence: 2
 - Venue rovers: ≥ 6

CCC requirements

- CARES: ≥ 15
 - Field deployment
 - Barricades
 - Venue rovers
 - Net control operators
- CERT: ≥ 20
- MRC: 6

July 4 Event: Agencies

- Sheriff's Office
 - 27 Deputies
 - Venues:
 - Miller Ave: 4
 - Sedgwick: 2
 - Creekside: 1
 - Three teams of two motorcycle deputies
 - Staffing road blocks and patrolling perimeter streets
- County Fire
 - On-site engine to douse roof fire
- Public Works
 - Unprecedented scope of street closures and traffic control

July 4 Timeline (Tentative)

4:00—Miller Ave. closes

5:00—All other streets close (one hour earlier than past years)

5:00—CARES / CERT / MRC / Mutual Aid volunteers check-in at TBD

5:15—Welcome and DSW swear-in for all volunteers

5:30—Pizza dinner

5:50—Briefing, post assignments, equipment issue

6:00—Depart for post assignments

6:15—Call-in from post assignments

8:25—Sunset

~9:30—Fireworks begin

10:00—Check Hyde School for fireworks debris, clean and breakdown other posts

10:30—Road closures eased

11:00—Event complete. Group leaders check group members out via net control, and return documentation and equipment to Incident Command at Hyde
