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# Purpose of Rapid Needs Assessment

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- RNAs determine the
  - Scope of the disaster
  - Assess what resources are necessary to conduct life-saving and life-sustaining operations
  - Provide state officials with quick and accurate information to enable them to determine whether State and/or Federal assistance is warranted

# Rapid Needs Assessment Goal

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- Provides the first description of the type and extent of damages and associated impacts sustained by the community.
- Goal: determine the scope of disaster.
  - How bad is it?
  - What areas are affected?
  - How many people are affected?
  - What are the risks to life, safety, and health?
  - What is the status of lifeline services?

# Results of Rapid Needs Assessment

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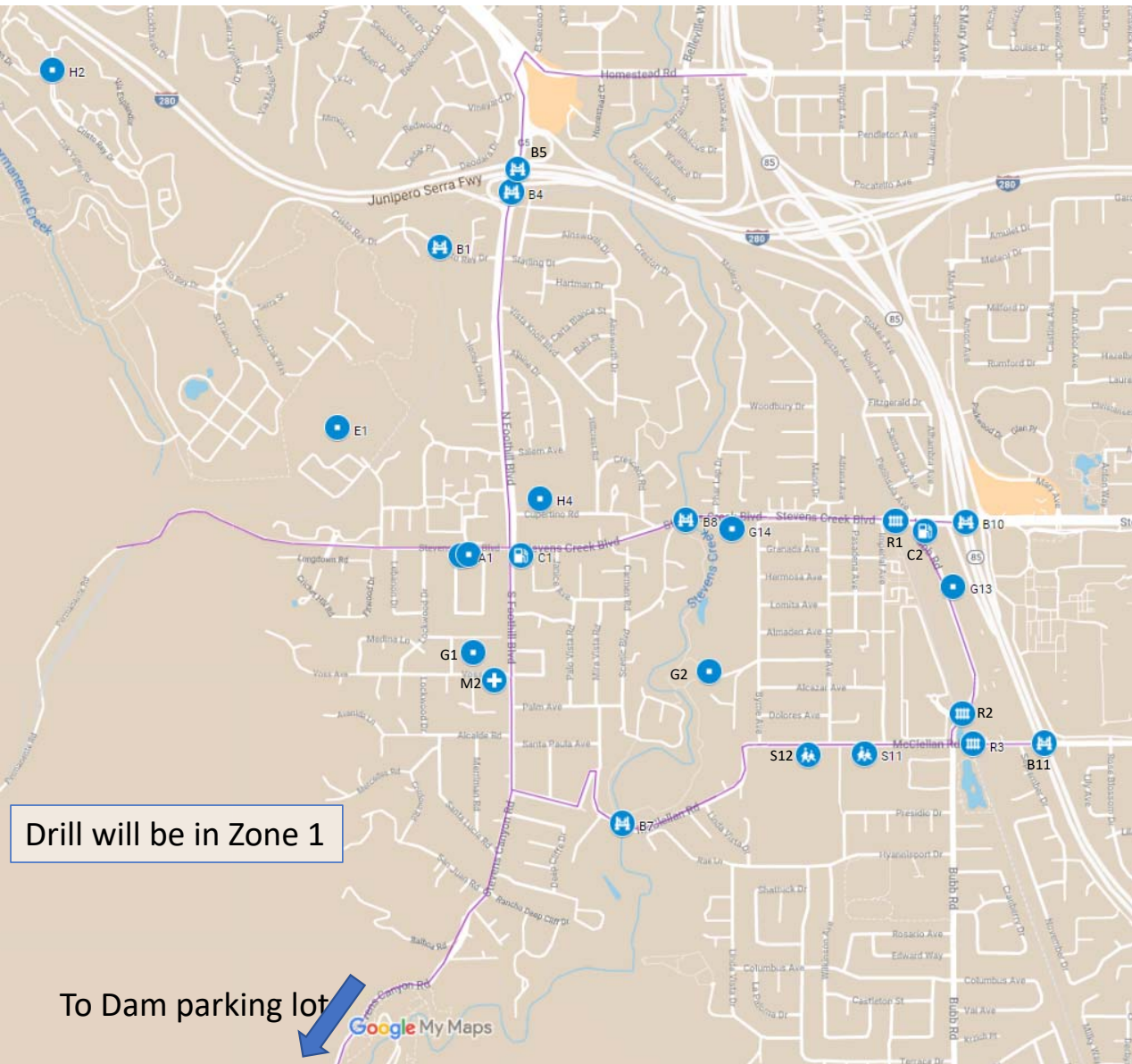
- The following questions need to be answered in the first 12–72 hours following the disaster incident to get help to victims:
  - What is needed?
  - When is it needed?
  - Where is it needed?
  - How much is needed?
  - For how long will it be needed?
- A rapid needs assessment takes place within hours after an incident and focuses on:
  - Lifesaving needs
  - Imminent hazards
  - Critical lifelines

# Elements of Rapids Needs Assessment

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- Bridges
- Schools
- High density housing
- Churches
- City buildings
- Hotels
- Medical facilities
- Retail food stores
- Stevens Creek Dam
- Transportation: signals, main thoroughfares
- Infrastructure: water, sewage, electricity, gas
